

It can be washed, boiled, ironed or mangled, without loss of efficiency, is extremely strong, yet neat and invisible in wear. Made in 10 colonrs, $\frac{7}{8}$ " wide, it costs 4d. per inch.

"Rigilon" is a nylon ribbon stiffener, replacing uncomfortable, old-fashioned boning, light and pleasant to wear, flexible yet durable, and easy to sew. It can be washed or dry-cleaned within the garment without loss of stiffness, dries quickly and does not crack. It has soft edges for easy sewing and leaves a smooth end when cut. Ideal for stiffening or shaping strapless things, excellent for narrow belts and giving crispness to bows, pockets and collars, it is made in black and white, ½" wide, and costs 1/3d. per yard.

Terylene Skirt Belting is made for waistbands of skirts and slacks. It is designed for use with all man-made fibres and the latest finishes; ordinary skirt petersham ribbon is not, and this often results in disappointment when the garment is washed.
