**Lehrbuch der Tropenkrankheiten.** Herausgegeben von *E. G. Nauck*, unter Mitarbeit von *G. Fuhrmann, H. Knüttgen, H. Lippelt, W. Minning, W. Mohr, H. Mühlpfordt, E. Reichenow †, H. Vogel, A. Westphal, F. Weyer*. 2., überarbeitete Auflage. VIII + 450 pp., ill. — Stuttgart: Georg Thieme Verlag, 1962. DM 64.—.

Das Lehrbuch für Tropenkrankheiten von Nauck ist — besonders im deutschsprachigen Gebiet — bereits so gut eingeführt, daß es keiner weiteren Empfehlung bedarf. Die Neuauflage zeichnet sich, wie schon die Erstauflage, durch ihren klaren Aufbau, durch die gediegene Ausstattung und durch die sehr guten Abbildungen aus. Daß neben dem Kapitel «Bacillenruhr» noch die Pocken (mit zwei Abbildungen) neu in das Buch aufgenommen wurden, ist in Anbetracht der immer wieder aufflackernden größeren oder kleinern Pockenepidemien in aller Welt, sehr zu begrüßen. Allerdings vermischen wir in diesem Kapitel einen Hinweis auf die relativ häufigen und zum Teil sehr schweren ossären und periostitischen Komplikationen der Pocken. Nachdem Pocken und Bacillenruhr neu in das Buch aufgenommen wurden, fragen wir uns, ob in einer weiteren Auflage nicht auch das Wichtigste über die Haemoglobinopathien, die besonders im tropischen Afrika recht häufig gesehen werden, aufgenommen werden könnten. Wir sind uns der Vorteile des beschränkten Umfangs eines Lehrbuches vollkommen bewußt und verstehen, daß bei Berücksichtigung aller Wünsche das Buch bald auf den doppelten Umfang anwachsen würde. Es scheint uns aber, daß z. B. die Sichelzellanämie, die ja mit wenigen Ausnahmen auf die dunklen Rassen und auf die eigentlichen Tropengebiete
