ÖSTERREICHISCHES SEMINAR FÜR INFORMATIONSFACHLEUTE
Workshop on Modern Library and Information Practice

The first Austrian Workshop on Modern Library and Information Practice will take place in Graz from 28th March—14th April 1978.

The Workshop is organized by the Federal Ministry of Science and Research in corporation with the Graz Institute of Computerized Documentation and the Austrian Academy of Advanced Management. The main purpose of the seminar is to provide training and information for young university graduates in the field of information science who intend to prepare for responsible positions.

The main items of the programme will be the following subjects, to be considered in view of the latest developments:

- Computing and telecommunications in information handling
- Information retrieval
- Problems of library and information management

In addition, an introduction to lecturing techniques and didactics will be given.

The lecturers at the Workshop, headed by Dr. Franz Kroller, Director of the Library of the University of Graz, will be three members of the Faculty of the University of Sheffield, Postgraduate School of Librarianship and Information Science, and five members of Austrian institutions, all of them distinguished by considerable rhetorical and professional experience.

The Workshop serves the post-graduate training of qualified young experts of librarianship and information science and is open to interested participants on an international level. Lectures will be held in English and German. The number of participants is limited to 25.

EURIM 3:

*A European conference on the contribution of users to planning and policy making
for information systems and networks
25/27 April 1978, Künstlerhaus (Lenbachplatz), Munich*

The theme of EURIM 3 — the third of the important and successful EURIM series sponsored by Aslib with the Association Nationale de la Recherche Technique, Bibliothèque Royale de Belgique, Consiglio Nazionale delle Ricerche, Deutsche Gesellschaft für Dokumentation, NOBIN and NORDFORSK — is «The contribution of users to planning and policy making for information systems and networks». In this context, users are seen as information providers rather than the end users.

The programme deals with this theme under six main heads: Networks and users; Operations; Compatibility and standardisation; Financing, pricing, cost effectiveness; Education and training; International co-operation. Each session will open with one or two keynote papers by invited speakers. Among those who have already agreed to take part are Professor S. Abrahamsson, Göteborg University; Mme A. David, Institut Français des Combustibles et de l'Energie; A. E. Negus, INSPEC; John Page, International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis; Alex Tomberg, EUSIDIC and Royal Dutch Shell; Martha Williams, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. The second half of each session will consist of a forum during which the preceding speakers, reinforced by one or two others, will initially answer questions presented in advance by the audience. Delegates are invited to submit questions or brief statements within the subject field of the conference, and these questions or statements will be presented in full session by the questioners. It is expected that this will lead to further discussion and spontaneous questioning. The closing date for the submission of questions is 1 October.

An announcement and call for questions is available and being distributed. In October, details of sessions, papers and speakers, of the social programme, accommodation and travel arrangements will be published in a programme, accompanied by a registration form, which will receive the widest possible distribution by Aslib and the sponsoring organisations. 39th FID CONFERENCE AND CONGRESS

The 39th *FID Conference and Congress* will be held in Edinburgh, 18—25 September 1978 on the invitation of the United Kingdom National Member of FID, Aslib.

The Conference, 18 through 23 September, will consist of meetings of the FID General Assembly, the Council and the Executive Committee, as well as meetings of FID Committees. Also, a seminar on education and training will be held during the Conference week.

The Congress with the theme «New Trends in Documentation» will be held 24—28 September and will consist of several sessions where invited and contributed papers within the theme of the Congress will be delivered.

During each session considerable time will be devoted to open discussion on the papers as they relate to the theme.

Members of the International Organizing Committee for the Congress are: R.A. Gietz, V. Stefánik, H. S. White (FID Councillors), P. Judge and Peter Lázár (FID Vice-Presidents), K. R. Brown (Acting Secretary General), and L. Hilson (Director, Aslib).

Aslib will be responsible for the local arrangements for all the meetings.
