The Reinforced Concrete Association exists to develop and foster the use of *good* reinforced concrete, including of course prestressed concrete and any developments. It is unique of its kind and consists of designers, consulting engineers, architects, contractors, suppliers of materials and suppliers of plant. It issues a badge of identification to its members and the display of this emblem on notepaper, or in any other form, is a sign of quality in anything appertaining to the reinforced concrete industry.

Naturally, it takes great interest in education and it is almost solely responsible, with the Cement and Concrete Association, for the development of courses for technicians at present being carried out under the auspices of the City and Guilds Institution mentioned by Mr. Hill. It has, of course, taken many years to develop these courses even though it is fully realised that good design and workmanship can be ruined by unintelligent control at the concrete mixer.

The Reinforced Concrete Association has taken the lead in giving prizes annually to students at technician level at the various Technical Schools, and courses for craftsmen of this type are being carried out at the Hammersmith School of Building and Arts and Crafts, Great Britain.
