Dear Swiss families abroad
Schweizerhilfe, Foundation for Young Swiss Abroad and Pro Juventute would like by their activities to provide an opportunity for as many children as possible to get to know and love their homeland and their compatriots. Our holiday campaign once again is at the disposal of your children.

Eligible for participation:

- children of Swiss nationality or
 - children of a Swiss mother looking after the family on her own.
- Age groups 1963-1970 (invitees 1961-1970)

Duration of holiday:

- approximately 5 weeks within the months of July and August, according to holiday dates in country of residence.

Holiday possibilities:

- in Swiss families*
- for children from 7-14 years (invitees 7-16) whose parents are able to make a small or no contribution.

in children's homes

- for children in bad health
 - for children of 7-10 whose parents, according to their income, are able to pay the whole or main part of the cost.
- Cost per day and child: 17 to 27 Swiss francs, everything included.

in camps

- children from 10-14 who like simple holidays, happy companionship, sport and hiking and whose parents are able to pay all or nearly all the cost.
- Cost per day and child: 17-27 Swiss francs, all included.

Travelling:

- in Europe in accompanied groups by train. In case of necessary air travel children are met at airport in Switzerland. Travelling cost borne by parents or by arrangement.

Application forms:

- obtainable from Embassies and Consulates.

Latest application date:

- to reach your Embassy or Consulate: 15th March 1977.
- applications received after that date cannot be considered.

Registration fee:

- per child 12 Swiss francs on application.

Further information:

- from Embassies and Consulates.

Next summer the Swiss Event of the year 1977 will be held in Vevey: the famous FÊTE DES VIGNERONS.

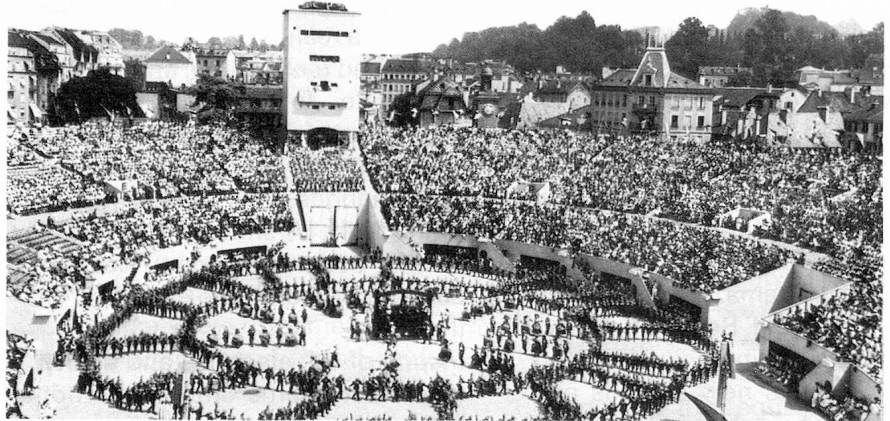

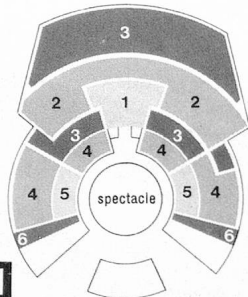
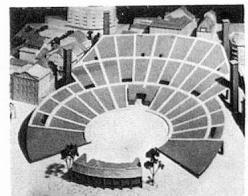
Reserve your places without delay
