Folk customs of our homeland on Swiss postage stamps

On 25th August the Swiss Post Office issued a magnificent series of postage stamps: folk customs from all regions of the Confederation. Thus our stamps once more prove to be little ambassadors, constantly bearing something new from our homeland into the wide world. Wouldn't you, too, like to secure a complete collection by means of a **new issue subscription at the Swiss Post Office?** A year's sets cost on average S.Fr. 18.—.

The subscriber is under an obligation to buy **at least two issues** in whatever form he/she chooses. Delivery is **post-free** four times a year. **Method of payment:** cash on delivery or current account. In the latter case a deposit of S.Fr. 50.— is required for two issues and S.Fr. 15.— for each additional issue. It can be paid by money order, banknotes or bank cheques. You need only complete the adjacent order form and send it to us – and you will already belong to the large family of satisfied regular recipients of Swiss postage stamps.
