

100 g Egg White)

80 g Sugar )Mix together for 8 Min. very hard

Add 120 g Sugar — Fold in very slowly

Dress it up (Bag). Put grease proof paper in a tray. Add a little oil and flour and put Meringue in. Heat oven to 110 C and bake for 1½ 'Hrs.'

11/4 Cup Salt

11/4 Cup Sugar

11/2 kg small Onions

2 Pints White Vinegar

Cloves, Estragon, Peppercorns

Combine Salt and Sugar in Bowl. Peal onions. Roll in Salt mixture and put coated onions into large sterilised jar. Add 2 Tbsp. of Salt mixture to each jar. Cover onions with vinegar, add 8 Cloves to each jar and a dash of Estragon and a few Peppercorns and fill the jar titely. Shake occasionally to desolve salt and sugar and let stand in cupboard for 3 weeks before ready.





#### 9.3. Advanced Electronic Topometry

It is only a few years since electronics were used in topometry for the first time but they have been gaining more and more importance ever since. A Swiss firm doing pioneer work in this field has just celebrated the production in its work of the 10,000th electronic topometry instrument, called a Distomat. This instrument makes it possible to measure distances to the nearest centimetre over a range of 2,000m by means of invisible infra-red rays and is used daily in over a hundred countries by surveyors, civil engineers, etc. (SODT) (Wild Heerbrugg AG, CH-9435 Heerbrugg, telex 77 191 wico ch)

## 9.4. New Processes for the Hygienization of Sewage Sludge.

Scientific research has shown that the use of nonsterilised sewage sludge as a fertilizer is a danger to human health. A big Swiss firm has developed processes for the hygienization of sewage sludge without impairing the fertilizing properties of the sludge. The first process, which is suitable for small and medium-size communities with a daily volume of 3 to 30 m<sup>3</sup> of raw sludge, enables the traditional two-stage sewage sludge treatment systems with aerobic and anaerobic stabilization and separate pasteurization to be replaced by more econoseparate pasteurization to be replaced by a more economical single-stage process. The second process is based on the action of gamma rays and is economical for medium-size and large communities having a daily throughput of 15 to 250 m<sup>3</sup> of sewage sludge.
