CONVENTION BETWEEN SWITZERLAND AND NEW ZEALAND FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBLE TAXATION WITH RESPECT TO TAXES ON INCOME.

The Convention which was signed on the 6th June 1980 and subsequently ratified by both contracting States, has entered into force on the 21st November 1981 after the instruments of ratification have been exchanged in Wellington on the 6th November 1981.

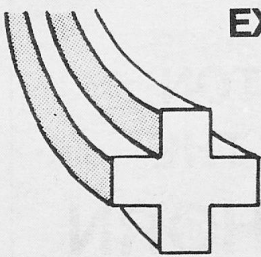

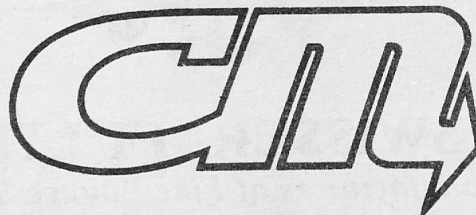
