

SWISS SCHOOL IN MELBOURNE

Extract of the minutes of the Annual General Meeting, Saturday, 6th February, 1982, Swiss Club of Victoria, 89 Flinders Lane, Melbourne

1. PRESENT

Consul-General Mr. W. Zellweger

2. ADDRESS BY THE PATRON, CONSUL-GENERAL MR W. ZELLWEGER

Mr. Zellweger greeted those parents present and thanked them for their interest in the school. He was glad to see that it had survived its seventh year in good health and he thanked Mrs. Fischer and the committee for their work and dedication. He expressed his hopes that the school would thrive for many years to come and indicated that it could only do so if it obtained the strong assistance from the parents. Some of the most rewarding tasks of the school, he said, were the tuition of Swiss-German, making the children aware of the many colourful shades and sounds this old language produces. In this context the Consul-General under-lined that without the assistance of the parents all the efforts of the teacher must be in vain.

3. REPORTS

The teacher, Mrs. Fischer, reported that she was very happy teaching at this school. This offered her the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to teach children at so many age levels and to teach them, to some extent, in Swiss.

She was rather disappointed, however, about casual and poor attendance. Student numbers were at times as low as 8 and she felt 15 to 20 would be an acceptable number. Mrs. Fischer also thanked all parents for their participation during the lessons and indicated that she would like to operate on a similar basis this year.

Mrs. Fischer warned parents that there would not be much visible progress with their children, particularly as far as Swiss-German was concerned. However, the children were trying hard at school and were doing their best.

The convenor, Mrs. Albisser, thanked the teacher and the parents for their support and co-operation. After holding her position for two years, she would like to step down and hand over her responsibilities to someone who could spend more time in that capacity than she could.

An extended discussion followed that centres around the question whether the school was still a viable proposition. Disappointment was expressed about the very poor attendance of the General Meeting. It was suggested that there might be many Swiss parents around who could be interested in the school if they were properly informed of its existence.

The meeting then resolved that school should carry on for the time being so that attendance and interest could be properly assessed. The secretary was instructed to liaise with the Consul-General so that a letter could be sent out to all potentially interested parents.

As time ran out, neither the treasurer nor the secretary were able to read their reports. The treasurer handed out the balance sheet covering the past year.

Both the treasurer and the secretary handed in their resignations from their positions and from the committee. As indicated above, the convenor's position is also vacant. No elections could be held due to the absence of interested parties. The committee is therefore vacant but the previous office holders agreed to carry on on an interim basis pending resolution of the present difficulties.


