

All members who have not yet paid for 1981 or 1982 are requested to make their payments before the end of February 1983. Short summary of the speech of Mr Marcel Ney, Director of the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad, on November 2, 1982 at the Swissclub in Johannesburg.

After a short description of the functions and duties of the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad, Mr Ney proceeded to elaborate on questions which at the time concerned most Swiss abroad.

AHV/IV

Mr Ney pointed out the importance of wives of compulsary insured husbands, to join the voluntary scheme. For this reason they should contact the competent Consulate as soon as possible. Furthermore, Mr Ney advised that wives having their own income, whose husband is already a member of the scheme are obliged to pay contributions according to their salary. An insured person who has paid contributions for at least one year is entitled to an ordinary disability pension, if he is at least 50 per cent (in case of hardship at least one third) disabled. The disabled wife of a voluntarily insured husband is therefore granted a pension only if she has ever personally paid contributions for at least one whole year. Only membership at the time of the occurance of disability entitles a disability pension.

Medical Insurance for returning emigrants

With the Union of Swiss Insurance Companies it was possible in 1976 to come to an agreement, that returning emigrants up to the age of 70, could join most Medical Aid Societies, within six months of their return to Switzerland. Mr Ney nevertheless pointed out, that due to the substantial price increase at the Health Sector, the Medical Insurance premiums are extremely high.

Citizenship

The question of Citizenship for children of Swiss mothers and foreign fathers is to be treated at the same time as the new regulation concerning the new law of naturalization of foreigners, which may cause a certain delay.

As the National Councils Election will take place in 1983, the citizenship campaign can only be submitted to public vote at the earliest during 1984. In Switzerland the women organisations are supporting the issue that all children of Swiss mothers and foreign fathers acquire Swiss citizenship. However, the Council of Europe has a rather negative attitude towards this project as it will result in even more persons holding dual citizenship. The new law will possibly bring a new regulation regarding the acquisition of Swiss citizenship to foreign women, who marry Swiss nationals. These women will no longer automatically acquire Swiss citizenship through marriage, but only after a certain time of marriage and domicile in Switzerland. It is also being examined whether foreign men marrying Swiss women should be granted the same right.

"Ausbildungswerk" for young Swiss abroad

This organisation arranges study and apprentiship opportunities in Switzerland for young Swiss abroad, and assists them in providing bursaries from the competent authorities.

Youth Camps for Swiss children abroad

These camps organized by the Secretariat for the Swiss abroad, are available to children of Swiss mothers and foreign fathers as well. Mr Ney ascertained that young people from South Africa seldom participate in such camps.

Solidarity Fund

Mr Ney insists that it is not only an insurance against total loss of livelihood due to political events, but the membership with this fund also provides legally the possibility to transfer money to Switzerland.

In conclusion, Mr Ney emphasized that the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad is an independent Organisation being part of the "Neue Helvetische Gesellschaft". It draws its funds partially from contributions from the Committee of the National Day Celebrations (sale of Emblems and Postage Stamps) and partially by Government Subsidy through the Department of Foreign Affairs.
