Swiss emigrants are known to assimilate fairly easily in their new surroundings and to make the best of the situation. 





A friend has passed away...

Mr. René Bovey, a former representative of the Secretariat of the Swiss Abroad, has died after a long illness on 14th of January 1982.

Mr. Bovey, well known to many of our readers, joined the Secretariat in 1957. He was in charge of the French-speaking division and editor-in-chief of the «echo».

After having earned a licentiate degree at the University of Lausanne, he worked as Rome correspondent for various Swiss newspapers from 1934 to 1938. Back in Switzerland he took a job as language and history teacher at the higher trade school in Lausanne and at the University of




Lausanne. Towards the end of the Second World War he was named delegate of the International Committee of the Red Cross. As such he visited many European nations, among them Hungary during the insurrection of 1956.

In 1966 he left our organization to become vice-director of the «Swiss Political Correspondence» where he was the head of the French-speaking division.

He always remained close to our organization, however, and we lose in him a committed friend. In the name of all Swiss abroad we wish to convey to his family our deeply felt sorrow.
