A very successful 1 August National Day celebration was held at the Maseru Club. Thanks to all those which attended. Now we have pleasure in publishing some details on one of the Swiss Organisation which is very active to assist Lesotho in the development of the country (special thanks from the Editor of the Swiss Review to his correspondent in Maseru A. Graf for compiling the.report):

Helvetas Organisation in Lesotho

Helvetas is a private Swiss Development Aid Organisation, active in 17 countries worldwide.

Often their Organisations are supported of co-operate with Govt. Departments.

In Lesotho Helvetas is integrated in the Department of Rural Development and is responsible for the implementation of Village Water Supply Section, (VWSS).

The first delegates of Helvetas started the Project in 1978, and at that time VWSS was a small badly organised and not very productive section.

2 Delegates in Maseru and 2 in Butha Buthe in the North began to instal Water-supplies which technically and qualitative were most suitable to the local conditions.

The development of good and conforming standards of workmanship was the main aim during the first years.

Later it was realised that good quality workmanship could only be achieved with properly trained workers.

In 1981 therefore 3 qualified Construction Engineers arrived from Switzerland to intensify the Training and Education. One of these Experts is a teacher in a Trade School to train the Bricklayers. Then there are 4 Project Engineers and 4 Construction Engineers working on the Project.
