With pleasure we now publish a message from the new Ambassador of Switzerland Mr. J.O. Quinche:

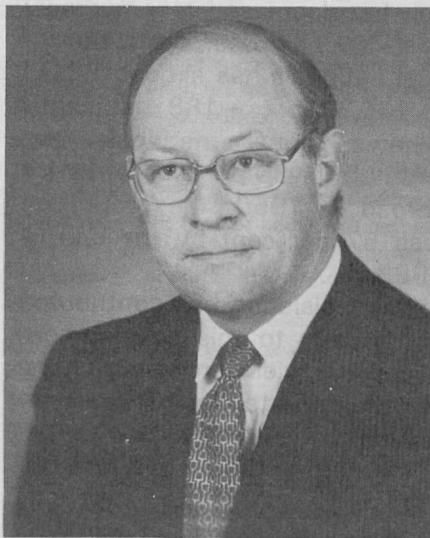
Dear Compatriots,

Max was present at our celebration and brought the greetings from the Eidg. Schuetzenverband.

We are pleased to publish the following Message from the Chargé d'affaires of Switzerland in Zimbabwe and our best wishes accompany Mr. A. Simon.

The Swiss Government has decided to terminate my mission to Zimbabwe. A successor will be named in the near future.

The time has therefore come to leave Zimbabwe after having headed the Swiss

representation, since May 1980. It is also time to take leave of the Swiss community and notably, time to thank all those who, during these years, have assisted me in one way or another.

Being more than 450 people, you are one of the most important and representative communities in Africa. In consideration of your worthy attitude, your qualitative work, you are on the whole an important component of the image of our country in Zimbabwe. You are also a contributing factor in the relations between Zimbabwe and Switzerland. I congratulate you as well as the Swiss Clubs of Harare and Bulawayo, the members of the committees and their presidents.

In taking my leave, my thoughts turn particularly, to those of our compatriots who are sick, disabled, alone or elderly. I think of those who question the future with distress and the decisions which that future might impose on them. I ask them not to lose courage, to persevere and to remember that every cloud has a silver lining. Lastly, to all of you, I wish perseverance, happiness and prosperity.

In the sense of a last wish, I hope that, when the time comes, you will carry over to my successor the same confidence and support that you have given me. Zimbabwe will remain in my recollection as a blessed personal and professional experience. *André Simon*
