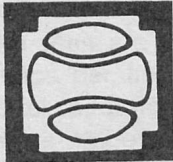

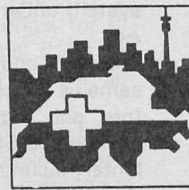

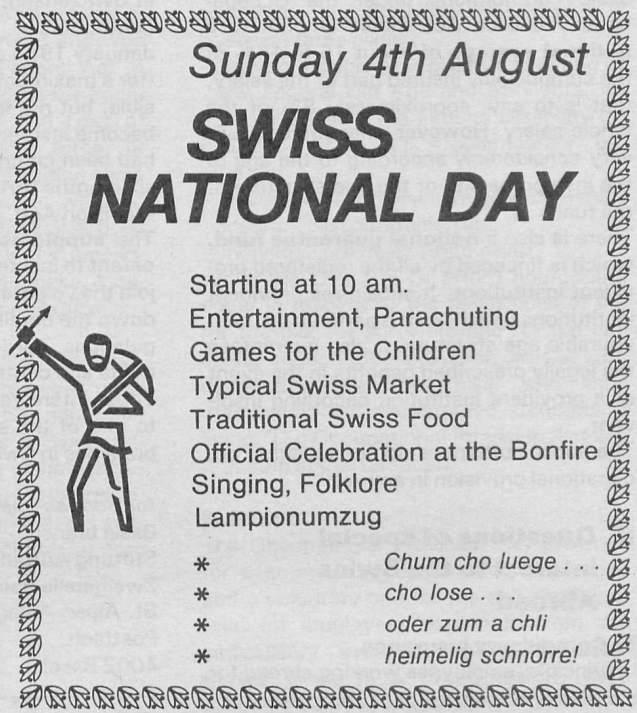

A summary of the achievements to date:

In the last 3 years the following water systems have been built which serve the population as indicated.

	1981	1982	1983
Systems installed	33	45	88
Population served	18 000	24 000	44 000

It is hoped to build in 1984 approx. 100 water distribution systems and to serve an additional 55 000 people with good clean drinking water.

Since 1980 approx. 110 Bricklayers have been trained in 3 month courses. 29 Foremen have completed the 9 months course. 5 construction leaders have been trained in the 6 months course.

Despite all the achievements a lot remains to be done, especially for the training and education.

Helvetas therefore continue with the Project and the target is to be able to see the VWSS becoming self sufficient and managed by well trained and motivated local staff.

We are confident this will be achieved with goodwill and co-operation of all involved in the project.

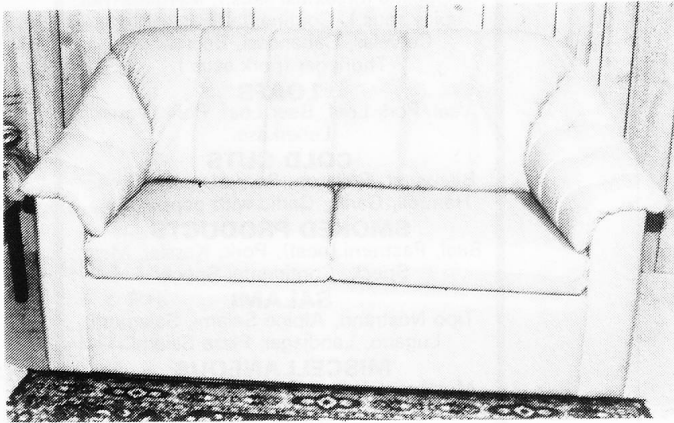

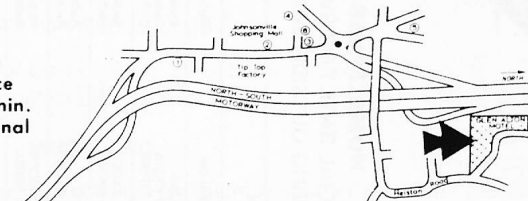

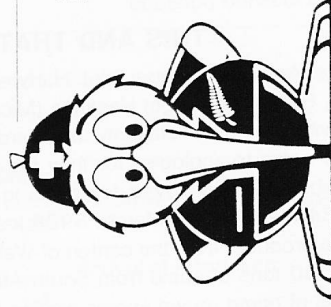

SUURE MOCKE

Brine: 5 dl red wine (dry)	Bring
1 dl vinegar	to the
1 onion spiked with whole cloves and bayleaves	boil &
1 carrot (peeled and cut in cubes)	cool
5 juniper berries	down
Rosemary twig	

1 kg beef roast, cover totally with cold brine. Soak for 5 days in cool place.

Heat 1 tablespoon of oil in frying pan, brown roast all over, take out, fry carrot and onion with cloves and bayleaves, take out. Roast 1 tablespoon flour and 1 teaspoon sugar until brown. Add 1 dl stock (hot), 1 dl brine, ½ dl red wine, salt, pepper. Add roast, carrot and onions and simmer for 2 hours occasionally pouring stock over meat.

Serve with mashed potatoes.

THIS AND THAT

— The former American bomber pilot, Hartwell Davis from Virginia and his co-pilot, Robert Cary from Hastings (Michigan) visited Thayngen (SH), the village they mistakenly bombarded on Christmas Day, 1944. They came to apologise for their terrible mistake.

— The number of unemployed fell again in April. It now stands at 32,691, 1846 less than in March, 3908 less than a year ago.

— The apple producer from the canton of Wallis protested against the import of 1500 tons of apple from South Africa since there are still 19,000 tons of home grown apples waiting in the coolstores.

— Ten years ago Swissair opened a line from Zurich to Peking with a DC-8. Today the same route is flown with a DC-10 and the waiting lists are growing. Swissair applied for a second flight and hopes to start flying in summer '86.

CONTRACT BETWEEN SWITZERLAND AND CHINA

Ems-Inventa Ltd, an engineering company in the Swiss Ems group, has signed a big contract with the Foshan Textile Industrial Co., at Foshan in the People's Republic of China for the setting up of a big polyester production plant. The project will cost 170 million francs to complete, and Ems-Inventa's share of the contract is 85 million francs. Ems-Inventa is responsible for installing two permanent systems for the polymerisation of polyester fibres. The plant is designed for a daily output of 180 tonnes of polyester.

This is the fourth contract that the firm has succeeded in gaining in the People's Republic of China this year, in the face of keen European and Japanese competition. These orders represent a total of 120 million francs for Ems-Inventa.

A LAND OF HOLIDAYS

From the first still provisional results published by the Federal Office of Statistics it appears that the establishments covered by Swiss tourist statistics recorded some 74.3 million overnight reservations in 1984, i.e. 1.1 million or 1.5% fewer than in 1983. The downward trend which started after the record year 1981 continued therefore during the year under consideration.

This slight drop, which occurs however within the context of a general recovery in the world economic situation, is undoubtedly due mainly to unemployment, which has assumed alarming proportions, and to the not very reassuring prospects offered by the labour market. In addition, the high exchange rate of the Swiss franc has made itself felt abroad, except of course among American and Japanese tourists.

The drop occurred wholly in the parahotel trade; in the different forms of accommodation it comprises, 1.5 million overnight stays fewer than in the previous year (-3.5%), were recorded, whereas hotels and convalescent homes gained 0.4 million (+ 1%).
