LETTER from the editor...

It is difficult to write for the Swiss Review: anything topical is out because of the long deadlines; there is not enough space for philosophising, and the readership is too diverse. This time, I am addressing myself to a very special reader: the compatriot who is a long time resident of New Zealand, not a member of a Swiss Club, a bit out of touch with things at home, but interested...

First then, the very condensed news from Switzerland: The EEC countries become ONE big market by 1992. This unification of almost all economic activities in Europe, with the exclusion of Switzerland, looms dark and menacing over our home country. For political, social and economic reasons, Switzerland is unable to join the Community. To secure the all important European export markets, bilateral treaties have to be concluded with each of the 12 member countries.

The 12 also form an almost irresistible pressure group in other areas, especially transport. Ever since the Middle Ages, the main North-South Trade Routes have passed through Switzerland. For centuries that was a blessing, but it has now become a nightmare. The Community demands free through passage for 40 tonne trucks, day and night, seven days a week. The quality of life of the people in the most affected areas in the Cantons of Uri, Ticino and Graubunden would certainly suffer and the increase in air pollution would adversely affect the already dying forests.

At present, Switzerland enforces protective traffic regulations as to weight of trucks and hours of operation. The existing roads over and under the alps could not cope with the density of traffic and the weight should the Community force Switzerland to rescind the regulations. Not very good news this time - I'll try to pick something more cheerful for the next issue. L.N.

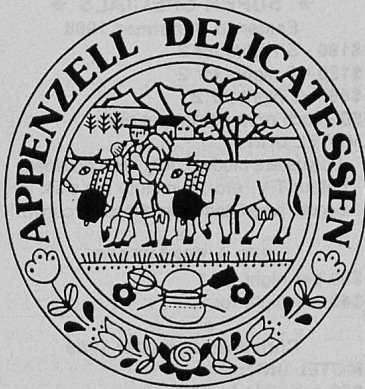
