

1941 and 1991

Enduring works

Did you know that the Swiss abroad made a visible contribution already on the occasion of the 650th birthday of the Swiss Confederation? In connection with the project of the Fifth Switzerland for the 700-year celebration in 1991, important developments are expected in September 1988.

The Place of the Swiss Abroad, which is the central contribution of the Fifth Switzerland to the 700th birthday of the Confederation, is part of the «Path of Switzerland» around the Lake of Uri, and should symbolize the ties of the Swiss abroad to their homeland. It should also remain a permanent institution accessible to the public, and




serve later as a meeting place. (See also Swiss Review 1/88 and 2/88.)


It is not the first time that the Swiss abroad commemorate their homeland on the occasion of an anniversary. On the 650th

birthday of Switzerland they made a contribution which has survived the years. In the war year 1941 they donated to Switzerland the impressive sculpture «A Monument to Defense Readiness», that huge composition of a soldier by sculptor Hans Brandenberger, which stands today in front of the Archives of the Federal Charters in Schwyz - in the immediate vicinity of the future Place of the Swiss Abroad in Brunnen.

Decisive developments

In September 1988 decisive developments will be imminent: The peninsula in the Bay of Brunnen should become the possession of the Foundation for the Place of the Swiss Abroad at the end of the month. The fund-raising drive continues


