Something of special interest to young Swiss abroad

Exchange visits

In connection with the arrangements for «Encounter 91», plans are going ahead for an advance pilot scheme already in 1990, namely for a programme of exchange visits for young people.

The concept for this project is on the one hand to arrange for short holiday stays lasting one to three months with Swiss families by young Swiss normally resident abroad, and on the other hand, for reciprocal visits by young Swiss from here, to stay with families of expatriate Swiss in other countries.

The Youth Service of the Secretariat for Swiss Abroad will be organising these exchange visits jointly with several partners, namely the Federal Department for Foreign Affairs, the institution called the "Swiss Foundation for Federal Collaboration" and a specialised organisation

"AFS Intercultural Programmes". The exchange scheme is at present aimed at young Swiss citizens in the age group 16 to 20 years resident either in Switzerland or in other countries, taking the form of individual exchanges during the summer holidays in 1990.

Any Swiss families resident abroad, who might be interested in arranging for their son or daughter to take part in such a reciprocal exchange with a Swiss family in the "home country" are requested to get in touch with the Secretariat for Swiss Abroad, Attention: Youth Service, Alpenstrasse 26, CH-3000 Berne. Multi-Sports Summer Camp 1990

Our Youth Service will be organising a holiday camp of predominantly sporting character at the National Youth Sports Centre at Tenero in the Ticino, close to Locarno (see our photograph). Emphasis will be laid on such types of sporting activity as canoeing, swimming, archery, tennis and badminton. But there will plenty of other arrangements, such as cultural events and excursions to nearby destinations, to prevent monotony.
