The architectural competition for the "Place of the Swiss Abroad"

Everybody's now invited

As mentioned in issue 1/90 of "Swiss Review", the contest has attracted tremendous interest. The prize-awarding jury has consequently decided to invite all expatriate Swiss architects who had by the deadline of December 1, 1989 applied to take part in the contest, to submit proposals for the design.

The members of the jury felt that it would not be fair, in the light of the many applications received, to request only seven architects to submit designs, as originally planned. All the applicants have now been given time until October 15, 1990, for elaborating and submitting their designs. And in December 1990, the prize-awarding jury will make its selection.

Plans for '91

The Council of the Foundation for the "Place of the Swiss Abroad" has decided to erect by 1991, on the site of the "Place", to act as part of the permanent infrastructure, a prestigious assembly tent with a capacity of some 2,000 persons. This tent will not be used only for festivities, other activities, and exhibitions for the expatriate Swiss, but will also be available to third parties. It is expected that the "Place" will thereby be able to accentuate its character as a venue for meetings and encounters in the spirit of the "leitmotiv" of the whole

700-year celebration. In the opinion of the Council of the Foundation the rest of the grounds should comprise a plain garden, with pathways and seating facilities, and should be decorated with the flags of the countries in which many expatriate Swiss reside. For financing all this, apart from donations from individuals, it is hoped to obtain contributions from sponsors.

The Council of the Foundation has furthermore set up an Organising Committee, to be responsible for the detailed planning and the actual performance of the work needed to get the "Place" completed by 1991. Mr. Heinz Bysäth, from Brunnen, a civil engineer, has been nominated as President of the Committee, whose other members have for practical reasons been recruited from prominent personalities from Brunnen and Schwyz. The Organisation of the Swiss Abroad will be represented on the Committee by Professor Walther Hofer. SSA
