

Special stamps



The Swiss Post Office has issued special stamps to mark the 700th anniversary of the confederation. The joint Swiss-US issue is particularly spectacular, showing the two imposing parliamentary buildings of the two capitals – the Federal Parliament in Berne and the Capitol in Washington. The fact that the USA is a traditional emigration land in which many Swiss have found a new home means that this joint issue takes in the Swiss abroad as well as the Swiss at home.

Another new stamp creation is the series of four stamps designed by Lausanne graphic artist, André Bovey. It symbolises Switzerland's four linguistic regions. An 80c stamp is dedicated to yet another anniversary – the 800th birthday of Berne – a date which will be marked by a series of special events.

It was in 1908 in an old schoolroom at Matten near Interlaken that a young teacher described the birth of the Confederation to his pupils. In the German language periods they became engrossed in Schiller's «Willhelm Tell». They were enthusiastic when their teacher suggested they should perform the drama in a nearby wood. It was from these modest beginnings that the «Tellspiele» in Interlaken grew. In 1991 it will be performed no fewer than 20 times.


Two hundred amateur actors and actresses and horses will bring Schiller's drama about freedom and self-determination to life once again.

Helvetian Gold

To mark the 700th anniversary of the Swiss Confederation the Swiss National Museum is housing an exhibition entitled Helvetic Gold. This exhibition gives us an impression of one of the most fascinating crafts of Celtic times. The Helvetians inhabited the Swiss lowlands during the 1st century B.C., and their treasures included a decorated golden goblet as well as extremely valuable jewellery.





Niklaus von Flüe at Martigny

In Roman times Martigny was the gate to the Great St. Bernhard Pass, and excavations have revealed the importance of this former capital of the canton of Valais. The amphitheatre has now been restored to mark the 700th anniversary of the Confederation, and the opening ceremony on 15 June 1991 will feature a performance of "Niklaus von Flüe". This historic drama is played in thirty different scenes. The music was written by Arthur Honegger. The large-scale performance will be

accompanied by "l'Orchestre des Rencontres Musicales" conducted by Paul Sacher and a choir of 230. The main actors will be Jean Winiger and Michel Orphelin, who plays Niklaus von Flüe. A young Canadian artist, Bruno Verdi, is in charge of choreography.

Performances: 15 June (official opening of the amphitheatre), 20 June, 22 June 1991.



The reception will take place on 1 August between 4 p.m. and 5 p.m. in the Botta Tent, which will stand on the Place of the Swiss Abroad from 20 July to 5 August. During this time the tent will be used for various events and therefore cannot be visited at certain times.




be proof that the Place of the Swiss Abroad is an important link with the Swiss Path.


