At the end of March 1992, SRI introduced a new programme structure. This has resulted in a general increase in the number of Swiss-related subjects and a clear distinction between programming for the Swiss abroad and non-Swiss audiences. English and French have been chosen as the key languages in communicating with non-Swiss audiences worldwide.

Also new is SRI programming on the Astra Satellite for listeners in Europe.
