As a special feature we repositioned the Relief Sculpture in Bronze, produced by the Swiss artist Ernst Fries and donated to the club by him. The name of this work is "One for All and All for One", a truly great Swiss saying.

During December the citizens of Melbourne presented a unique Sundial Clock to the people of Switzerland.

In a reciprocal gesture of goodwill for the famous Floral Clock, which was given to Melbourne by the Watchmakers of Switzerland in 1966 and is located on St Kilda Road, the presentation was made to the Consul General of Switzerland, Mr Leo Renggli. The Sundial Clock which is 1.8m high and handcrafted from beautiful Australian materials, is named "Tjukurrpa", an Aboriginal word meaning "The Beginning of Time, the Dreamtime".

Members of the Trachten Gruppe Schwyzer Gruess, and the Folk Dance Group Alpenrose, provided a very colourful background in their National Costumes. The presentation was concluded by Irma Thalmann playing the Alphorn.

The function was held in front of the Floral Clock and was organised by Mr Graham Davies, the Managing Director of SMH, which was the major sponsor of the project.

SMH is the leading importer of Swiss watches such as Omega, Longines, Rado, Tissot and Swatch.

The Sundial Clock will be on permanent display in the Jura Region of Switzerland. Primo Calabresi


