Information on cassette

SRI is adding to the information available abroad by providing referendum cassettes in the three national languages. These may be obtained by those interested free of charge.

Swiss Radio International plays an important role when it comes to providing information for Swiss people liv-

ing abroad. It tries to update its services to fellow-citizens around the world as fast and as efficiently as possible, to reflect ever-changing needs and interests. With this aim in mind, SRI has considerably improved its reporting of the Swiss political scene, particularly of nationwide referendums and other polls, since the Swiss Abroad gained the right to vote by post.

Six weeks before federal votes, SRI broadcasts special programmes which explain the key issues and explore the background. By so doing, it tries to help Swiss citizens abroad exercise their political rights in an informed way.

SRI exists to serve its listeners. However, it is aware of the often considerable difficulties posed by international and especially by inter-continental communication. For this reason, in addition to its direct broadcasts, it also produces audio-cassettes in order to ensure that accurate and easy-to-understand information reaches its target. These cassettes are sent to Swiss citizens who express an interest six to eight weeks before polling day. They can be ordered from the following address:

The cassette programmes usually last about an hour. At the moment, they are available in French, German and Italian. On every polling issue, they contain opinions for and against voiced by relevant personalities. These programmes give Swiss citizens abroad the chance to

Working in cooperation with the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad and the Service for the Swiss Abroad at the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs, SRI has since October 1993 been broadcasting a special monthly programme for the Swiss Abroad. This is transmitted in German, French and Italian. The German and Italian programmes are broadcast on the last Sunday of each month. The French programme, called "Swiss Contacts", also comes at the end of the month – on the last Thursday and Friday. Times and frequencies are found in the SRI programme brochure.
