The OSA was set up in 1916 to represent the interests of the Swiss Abroad in Switzerland, to provide them with information about events in Switzerland and to supply a wide range of other services. Its executive body, the Council for the Swiss Abroad, is recognised by the

government as the spokesman of the Fifth Switzerland. Its office is the Secretariat for the Swiss Abroad (SSA). The latter's work includes an advisory service on legal matters, education and training; publishing Swiss Review; and organising activities for young Swiss Abroad (ski and sports camps, youth exchange).
