Post-doctoral fellowship abroad (SR 1/99)

I read with interest your article on research fellowships abroad for Swiss scientists but would like to point out the restrictive nature of the financial support available.

For several years I have been working as a research assistant at the Ludwig Maximilian University in Munich following completion of my degree in Zurich. To complete my thesis it is now imperative that I study in the USA.

However, since I am not a German national the German academic exchange service does not support me. Nor am I entitled to support from the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNF) since my thesis is not being submitted to a Swiss university. It would appear, then, that for Swiss Abroad academic mobility is practically impossible, while those that stay at home enjoy the generosity of the SNF for their post-graduate studies abroad.
