It was with a symbolic capital – a Goldvreneli – that a few Swiss nationals living abroad founded "The Solidarity Fund for Swiss Nationals Abroad" in 1958. For several years, this mutual-aid cooperative now known under the name of Soliswiss, has been offering a range of modern products in the areas of financial security and health insurance.

Even today, insurance against political risk remains at the very heart of Soliswiss' concerns and philosophy. However, over the past few years, its services and offers have developed considerably in order to better correspond with the needs of its members. In the area of long-term financial security, cooperation with some of the best Swiss insurance companies has allowed Soliswiss to offer

New Visual Identity

From the Spring of 2001, a new Soliswiss brochure will be avail-

able in five languages. It will mainly focus on Soliswiss members and their experience of life abroad. Apart from these testimonies, the coloured brochure will present Soliswiss services, in brief. Detailed information on each of these services (Political risk, savings, long-term financial security, and health insurance) will be given on the information leaflets accompanying the brochure. The new documentation will be available either through Soliswiss, or through Swiss embassies or consulates abroad.

Useful links and a broad range of updated information about Swiss political life will be offered.
