

LETTER FROM THE PRAIRIES

This year Saskatchewan is celebrating its centennial year with a number of special events. Two of the Swiss-Canadian artists of Saskatchewan are involved in centennial-related projects. Lotti Prokott, a professional sign painter working out of Pelly, has been commissioned by the town of Kamsack to paint a mural depicting the town's origin. Muriel Nuesch, a potter, painter and designer living in Shellbrook, is offering her ranch for the Parkland Artisan's Tour in Shellbrook, June 25 and 26. Saskatchewan is worth a visit, especially this summer.

The temperature in our province during the past winter never dipped to minus forty degrees. However, what it might have lacked in low temperatures the weather made up in other nasty features. 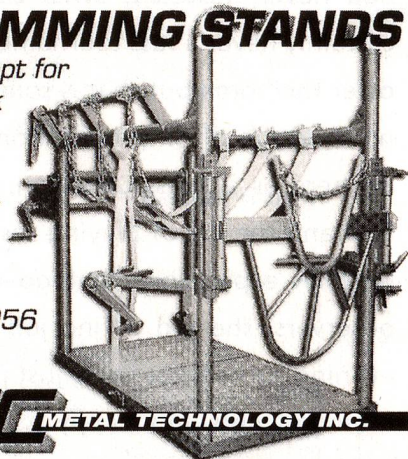

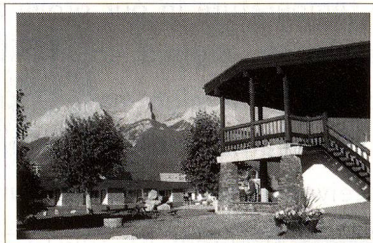
