



Farewell to Dr Maximilian Brandle, Representative, Council of the Swiss Abroad (CSA)

It is with some sadness that we are losing Max Brandle as a representative on the Council in which he has promoted the interests of the Swiss community in Australia for over 30 years.

Max was born and educated in Winterthur completing a commercial apprenticeship with the transport enterprise Panalpina in Zurich. After national service in the Swiss Army, he decided to come to Australia, where his first job was on the factory floor in Melbourne early in 1960. He completed his HSC in Sydney in 1961, followed by tertiary studies at the Universities of Queensland, Munich and Florence. When a doctoral student in Munich he did a few photo shoots, some with his wife, Anglo-Australian top model Annette Arundel. In 1968 he was appointed lecturer at the University of Queensland, where he taught for over 30 years. He became the first Swiss to be appointed to a professorial position in a Brisbane university.

Max was the Australian pioneer of the commercial single English language industry. He was a visiting lecturer or congress speaker in 12 countries, including opening speaker at an EU-sponsored international congress in Bonn. He published 12 books, including the centennial project 'Multicultural Queensland 2001', Dept of the Premier and Cabinet, Brisbane 383p (now out of print). In 1988 he was also project manager for a bicentennial book with the same title. This book became the catalyst for societal change in Queensland and paved the way for the adoption of multicultural policies.

He was co-founder of the Swiss Society of Queensland, 1965, and foundation editor of 'Swiss News Queensland', which still appears six times a year in the original

format. He has also served as President or Secretary of the Queensland Chapter, Swiss Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry. Max wrote a series of small monographs and articles on Australian-Swiss affairs, and two recent articles in German on the Swiss writer Robert Walser appeared in a book edited at Nancy University in France (published in Bern, 2002).

Max has given service to many community and government organisations. He is currently a VP of the Ethnic Communities Council of Queensland. During the last 12 years he was the co-organiser and MC for the official EU-Day functions in Queensland, which are held annually in the facilities of the State Parliament.

Max has received two Australian Government Honours, the OAM and the Australian Centenary Medal. The Queensland Government recognised him with a Queensland Migrant Service Award. The Dante Alighieri Society in Rome also recognised him with an award and the Dante Society in Brisbane made him an Honorary Life Member - Max served for four years as its President.

Max is now in active retirement. He is currently a Visiting Fellow at Griffith University and continues to serve as a director of the National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters (NAATI, Canberra).

We thank Max for his efforts not only on the Council, but for being such an outstanding member of our Community, and wish him good health and enjoyment.
