CONSULAR DISTRICT MELBOURNE

OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT

The Consulate General of Switzerland in Melbourne will close its doors by the end of September 2006. A Honorary Consul will be nominated.

The Department of Foreign Affairs in Berne has decided to close the Consulate General of Switzerland in Melbourne by 30 September 2006. As from 1 October 2006 all consular functions will be taken over by the Consulate General of Switzerland in Sydney.

This announcement and additional information as to the reasons to close was published in the Swiss Review No. 1 / March 2006 and No. 2 / April 2006.

We would like to clarify some points that we were asked about:

- You do not have to do anything! All files related to your registration with the Consulate General in Melbourne (Victoria, South Australia, Tasmania and Western Australia) will be transferred to the Consulate General in Sydney by 1 October 2006.
- All matters regarding passports, civil matters (births, marriages, deaths, divorces, changes in marital status, etc.), Swiss citizenship, naturalisations, visas, legalisations etc. will be handled by the Consulate General in Sydney from October 2006.
- Life certificates (for recipients of the Swiss Old Age Pension) to be returned to the AHV/AVS office in Geneva. Your signature has to be verified either by your local council, police station, or a notary public.
- A Honorary Consul will be nominated later and you will be kept informed.

INFORMATION ON NEW PASSPORTS (Deutsch, Français, Italiano)

• Fokus Schweizerpass

Weltweit wird derzeit an der Einführung von Pässen mit elektronisch gespeicherten biometrischen Daten gearbeitet - auch in der Schweiz. Ab 4. September 2006 können in der Schweiz biometrische Pässe im Rahmen eines maximal fünf Jahre dauernden Pilotprojektes beantragt werden. Der Pass der neuen Generation trägt die Kurzbezeichnung «Pass 06».

Der bisherige Pass vom Modell 03 wird während des Pilotprojekts weiter ausgestellt.

Wer einen Pass vom Modell 03 besitzt, dessen Ausstellungsdatum vor dem 26. Oktober 2006 liegt, wird bis zum Ablauf des Dokuments keinen neuen Pass 06 brauchen - auch nicht für eine visumsfreie Reise in und durch die USA. Wer sich deshalb den Pass 03 noch rechtzeitig ausstellen lassen will, muss diesen so rasch wie möglich bestellen. Spätester Termin: Mitte September, für Auslandschweizerinnen und Auslandschweizer Ende August 2006.

• Focus passeport suisse

L'introduction de passeports munis de données biométriques enregistrées électroniquement occupe actuellement le monde entier. En Suisse, il sera possible de demander un passeport biométrique dès le 4 septembre 2006 dans le cadre d'un projet pilote limité au maximum à cinq ans. La nouvelle génération de passeports est appelée «passeport 06».

Le passeport actuel (passeport 03) continuera d'être établi durant le projet pilote.

Les titulaires d'un passeport 03 établi avant le 26 octobre 2006 n'ont pas besoin d'un nouveau passeport 06 tant que leur passeport 03 est valable, même en cas d'entrée ou de transit sans visa sur le territoire des Etats-Unis. Les personnes souhaitant encore obtenir un passeport 03 dans les délais doivent le commander rapidement. Dernier délai: mi-septembre 2006 (fin août 2006 pour les Suisses de l'étranger). • Focus passaporto svizzero

In tutto il mondo e anche in Svizzera attualmente si sta preparando l'introduzione di passaporti provvisti di dati biometrici registrati elettronicamente. In Svizzera, a partire dal 4 settembre 2006, nel quadro di un progetto pilota che durerà al massimo cinque anni, sarà possibile richiedere un passaporto biometrico. La designazione breve del passaporto della nuova generazione è «passaporto 06».

L'attuale passaporto modello 03 sarà rilasciato anche durante il progetto pilota.

Chi possiede un passaporto 03 rilasciato prima del 26 ottobre 2006, fino alla scadenza del documento d'identità non avrà bisogno di un passaporto 06, neanche per entrare o fare scalo senza visto negli Stati Uniti. Chi intende ottenere in tempo un passaporto 03 deve pertanto richiederlo quanto prima e al più tardi entro metà settembre del 2006, mentre i cittadini svizzeri domiciliati all'estero devono presentare la richiesta entro la fine di agosto.
