The Department of Foreign Affairs in Berne has decided to close the Consulate General of Switzerland in Melbourne on 30 September 2006. As of 1 October 2006 the Consulate General of Switzerland in Sydney will be in charge of all consular duties, functions, most of the cultural activities and other business related to Swiss interests, including the satellite of the AHV/AVS - The Swiss Old Age Pension.

My staff and I welcome very heartily all Swiss compatriots from the circumscription of the closed Consulate General in Melbourne living in Victoria, South Australia, Tasmania, Western Australia and Nauru. From 1st October 2006, the jurisdiction of the Consulate General of Switzerland in Sydney will cover all Swiss citizens living in Australia, Kiribati, Marshall Islands, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Salomon Islands, Tuvalu and Vanuatu.

If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the Consulate General in Sydney. We all will be pleased to help and assist you in any matters of concern.

The new SACA year is now well underway. At the Annual General Meeting in July, SACA members put forward suggestions for the coming year and, most importantly, strongly supported a special resolution to introduce corporate membership. An open invitation is now extended to Swiss and Australian organisations to join SACA at a nominal fee for up to five staff members.

The AGM elected Marjorie Anderson, SACA Vice President, as its new President. Marjorie served as Vice-President to President Werner von Euw for three years and had worked with founding SACA President, Paul Frischknecht, on the Luginbühl Exhibition during the Sydney Olympic and Paralympics.

SACA aims to foster cultural exchange between Australia and Switzerland and already, has a commendable record of special events to its credit. Planning is in place for a number of cultural activities, some in close collaboration with the Swiss Consul General, Juerg Casserini, the active Patron of SACA.

Current events include a private showing of the Giacometti Exhibition, two art exhibitions in November - Arcadian Artists in early November and the Marbot Exhibition late November, and a year end family picnic at the 'Australian Angel' in December.
