### Consulate. TOPtoTOP

A few words from this Office regarding the expedition of the Swiss family, Dario and Sabine Schwörer and their two children, Salina and Andri.

The TOPtoTOP Global Climate Change Expedition, under the leadership of Sabine and Dario Schwörer started in Geneva on 3 December 2002. This expedition is the first one of its kind, in that it travels to the seven (7) summits to connect global climate zones in seven (7) continents around the world using only human power. This Swiss family have been sailing, cycling and climbing, and have already visited over 30 nations. The TOPtoTOp Expedition aims to focus attention on global climate change. TOPtoTOP is a Swiss non-profit organisation of volunteers under the patronage of the United Nations Environment Program. The project is largely sponsored by the famous Swiss Company VICTORINOX and supported as well by Presence Switzerland from the Swiss Federal Department of Foreign Affairs in Bern.

The Swiss couple with their two children arrived Downunder on Wednesday, 28 November 2007 aboard the sailboat Pachamama. The sailboat is THE example for the cruising world, of what is possible in extreme conditions with smart technologies. The family expects to spend about a year in Australia. While here, Sabine and Dario will give public presentations and visit interested schools at each destination. They will teach children about the importance of nature and give them various fun projects, to learn all about sustainability. The children are then encouraged to express their own ideas about how we can care more for our environment and climate in the TOPtoTOP International Climate Solution Contest.
