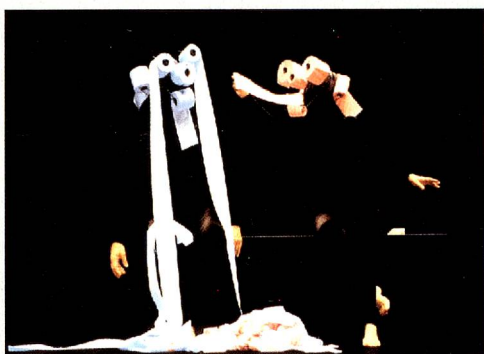

New Free Trade Agreement

The Free Trade Agreement came into effect from 1 May 2008. The Federal Department of Economic Affairs stated that the Agreement liberalises the trade in industrial goods and processed agricultural products.

The Free Trade Agreement between EFTA states and SACU states was signed in 2006. Parallel to the FTA, bilateral agreement on trade in agricultural goods were entered into between SACU and Iceland, Norway and Switzerland. These three bilateral agreements were "concluded pursuant to and in conjunction with the Free Trade Agreement" and "form part of the instruments establishing the free trade area between the EFTA states and SACU.

The EFTA states have lifted their tariffs completely from industrial goods and fish products on the 1st May 2008. The SACU states (South Africa, Botswana, Lesotho, Namibia and Swaziland) can continue to take advantage of custom duties during the transition process for up to nine years. However, there is a proviso that after five years the laws on intellectual property, trade of services, investment and public procurement can be reviewed.
