

The Swiss Australian Academic Network (SAAN), originally conceived as Swiss Academic Network Melbourne (SANM), aims to capitalize on the existing interest of academics from the two countries to foster and expand the bilateral exchange of academics at various stages of their professional careers and based on both countries' outstanding contribution to science and technology and being home to numerous internationally recognized academic institutions of excellence. On a local level SAAN is keen to foster the network idea among academic of different fields and within different states and to highlight achievements of Swiss in Australia and vice-versa.

SAAN is a grass-root organization which is open to Swiss and Australians who have connections to, or interest in, Switzerland; for this purpose SAAN has representatives in each Australian State who are very keen to support the SAAN vision in their own states with appropriate activities.

One of the major goals of SAAN is to reciprocally raise awareness and profile of the two countries and their relevant academic and non-academic entities among the best and brightest to expand on the exchange of excellence. At the same time, SAAN is keen to also encourage connectivity between academics in Switzerland with like-minded Australians who wish to broaden their professional knowledge. This will ensure that SAAN can act as a network and resource hub for people seeking exchange opportunities within the academic environment between Switzerland and Australia.
