On 25 February 2010 the Swiss federal government announced that it intends to discontinue its financial contribution to swissinfo as part of its budget program for 2011-2013.





This message of solidarity, probably inspired by Alexandre Dumas' novel "The Three Musketeers", became the unofficial motto of Switzerland in the middle of the 19th century, and in 1902 its Latin version "Unus pro omnibus, omnes pro uno" was inscribed in the cupola of the Federal Parliament (Bundeshaus) in Berne. Not surprisingly, the Swiss Society of New South Wales, which preceded the Swiss Club, quoted it (in French) in its annual reports from 1917 onwards.
