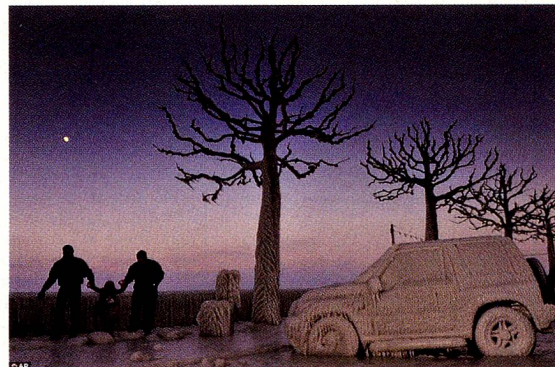

OSA. E-Voting & Bank Fees

E-voting is especially important for the Swiss abroad. Post delivered late, or to the wrong address, repeatedly prevents them from participating in elections and referenda. But there is also a strong interest in e-voting from within Switzerland, especially from the younger generation.

The Organisation of the Swiss Abroad has launched a petition calling for the introduction, as quickly as possible, of voting in elections and referenda via the Internet (e-voting and e-election).

The SAAN Network has continuously grown and its membership now surpasses 500 academics. In February, SAAN co-organised the first Swiss Alumni Meeting at the University of Sydney. Prof Jan Carmeliet, ETH Zürich gave a lecture about "Sustainable Cities and Urban Energy Systems of the Future". Over 40 Alumni from the universities of St. Gallen, Zürich, Lausanne, Geneva, ETH Zürich and EPF Lausanne were attending the meeting. SAAN will continue to facilitate the build-up of Alumni networks of Swiss universities in Australia.

SAAN is now also increasing its presence in South Australia, where it co-organised a first event at the University of South Australia.

The University of Melbourne, lead by its Vice-Chancellor Glyn Davis visited ETH Zürich, the University of Basel and EPF Lausanne, seeking to establish

partnership with the respective universities.

In January, SAAN launched a survey into issues inhibiting bilateral research collaboration. The results were presented to the Swiss and Australian governments, who are discussing to jointly form a committee looking at improving the legal framework for research collaborations.

SAAN-facilitated negotiations between Swiss universities and the Australian Group of Eight universities for an agreement supporting the bilateral exchange of early career-researchers are being finalised.
