Embassy. Message from Ambassador Marcel Stutz



Dear Compatriots in Australia, Kiribati, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands and Vanuatu.

The Swiss-Australian relations had a high-light with the visit of Federal Councilor Didier Burkhalter to Canberra on the 27th and 28th of October last year. Mr Burkhalter was the first Minister of Foreign Affairs to be welcomed

by the new Government in Canberra and the first Swiss Foreign Minister to officially visit the Pacific and Canberra. The Hon Julie Bishop and Federal Councilor Didier Burkhalter signed two agreements: one on the strategic cooperation between Switzerland and Australia wherein the Ministers agree to have biannual meetings; the other on Science, Research and Innovation. After the formal meetings, the Swiss Foreign Minister invited his Australian counterpart for a lunch at the Swiss Residence.

My objectives for 2014 are:

- to further improve the coordination between the different Swiss and Australian actors (Swiss Citizens, SwissCham, SAAN and the Consulate General in Sydney and our Honorary Consuls in the Northern Territories, Papua New Guinea, Southern Australia, Tasmania, Western Australia and Victoria)
- · to fill the signed agreements with life
- to organize the planned visit for the end of the year of an economic delegation headed by the State Secretary for Economic Affairs, Gabrielle Ineichen-Fleisch

I am very much looking forward meeting and working with you, our Swiss Compatriots – be it through direct contacts or be it through our highly efficient Swiss Clubs, spread out over whole Australia. 
