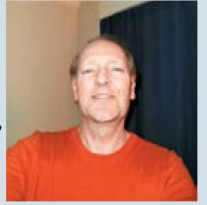

From the Consulate General of Switzerland in Vancouver: Consular Days in Calgary, AB

Dear Swiss Citizens:

With the introduction of the biometric passport, applicants must appear in person to record their biometric data: A photograph of the applicant and two fingerprints are required.

The mobile biometric passport station provides you with an opportunity to have your data taken in CALGARY, AB where our consular officers from the Consulate General of Switzerland in Vancouver will receive you from **May 13 through May 16, 2024**.

If your passport has expired, will expire in 2024 through 2027, or if you are a new applicant and would like to take advantage of this opportunity, please complete your application (one per applicant) for a new passport and / or Swiss ID card at the following website: www.schweizerpass.ch. Please note you can change the language in the top right-hand corner.

Please follow the procedure for Swiss nationals living abroad:

- It is absolutely critical that you enter "Calgary 2024" under "Remarks", otherwise your application will be processed automatically for an appointment in Vancouver;
- It is also mandatory that you enter a cell phone number and an email address;
- Please make a new application – even if you already have an active one with the Consulate;
- If you would like to make an appointment together with another family member / person, please indicate this in the "Remarks" section;
- Please ignore the automated confirmation email that you will receive after submitting your application.

Deadline for applications: February 25, 2024



Important: If your civil status (birth of children, marriages, divorces, passing of spouse, name) is not up to date with the Swiss registry at the time of the event, your application may not be considered.

Your application will be reviewed, but it will not guarantee an appointment. You will receive confirmation of the appointment together with information about the exact location, date, time, as well as further instructions (payment of **fees**, etc.) by March 31, 2024, at the latest. Please note we cannot consider specific date / time preferences.

You may also take care of the biometrics in Vancouver, or while on vacation in Switzerland where your personal scheduling preferences can be better accommodated.

Please feel free to pass this information on to other fellow Swiss.

The Consulate reserves the right to reschedule its Consular Days if the number of applications does not justify the visit, or for reasons of force majeure.

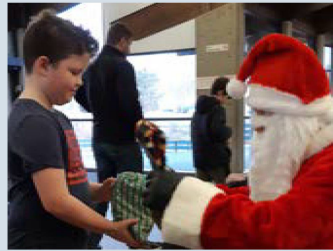

LE CANADA, passionnément !

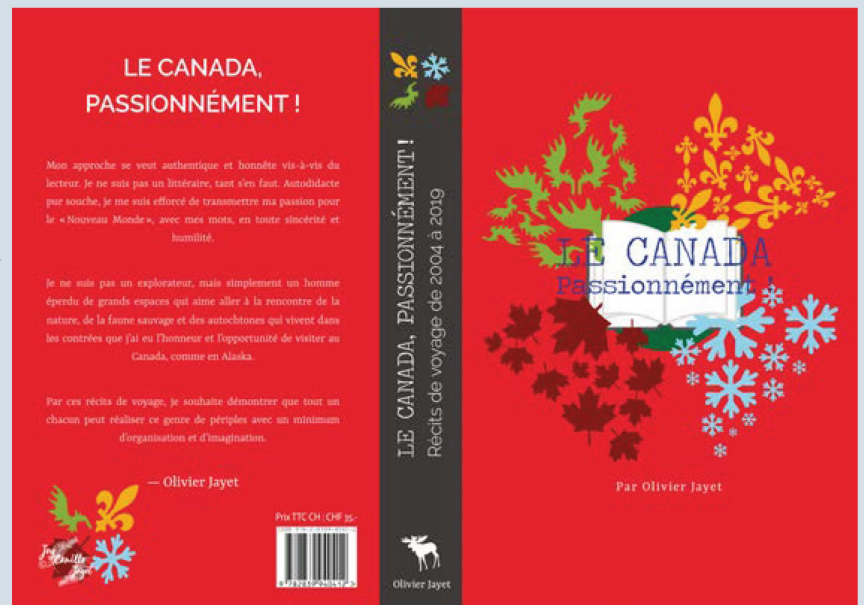
