News Items

Telephone

Olten telephone region (network groups Olten, Langenthal and Aarau) changed over to the new, three-digit information and emergency service numbers in April.

Switzerland currently operates 284 overseas satellite circuits. They are routed through the earth station of Leuk (229), Fucino (1), Goonhilly (4), Pleumeur-Bodou (24), Bercenay-en-Othe (1) and Raisting (25).

Switzerland's outgoing international calls last year totalled 364.97 million chargeable minutes of which 96.3 percent (1977: 95.3 pc) were subscriber dialled.

The gradual changeover to **computerproduced telephone directories** will enable the Flexoprint office to be closed by the summer of 1979.

Telegraph, Telex

Five direct telex circuits between Switzerland and Rhodesia were opened via Leuk—Salisbury on 5 March.

With the signing of an agreement the go-ahead has been given for Euro-

data 79, an extensive market survey which is to provide the planning basis for Europe's future data communication services.

Radio, Television

The vhf radio relay stations of St Chrischona near Basle (99.0 MHz), Rigi (96.6 MHz) and Monte Ceneri (89.4 MHz) have been converted for stereo broadcasting.

An agreement signed with the PTT will enable the Swiss Air Rescue Service to use Bäzberg multipurpose station near Andermatt for radio communication.

A multipurpose station was opened at Feschel (Ct Valais) in March. It serves as a microwave radio relay base for telephone and television links between Upper and Lower Valais and supplies large parts of the canton with vhf radio, television, and car radiopaging signals.

The PTT is building a **television relay station** at **Chardonne** (Ct Vaud) which is to supply France's three national programmes to the localities between Evian and St Gingolph on Lake Geneva's southern (French) shore.
