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III. FINANCIAL POSITION

The accounts for 1958 are shown, as customary, in Tables I and II giving the Balance Sheet and the General Account of Ordinary Expenditure and Receipts of the ICRC.

In its report dated May 14, 1958, the Société Fiduciaire OFOR S.A.*, entrusted with the verification of the accounts, stated: (translation)

- "In execution of the task entrusted to us by your Committee, we have verified the annual accounts of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) in Geneva, as on December 31, 1958.
- "After having checked the opening Balance Sheet as on January 1, 1958 we made numerous checks to ascertain the correctness and accuracy of the figures entered in the books for the year 1958 and assured ourselves, in particular, that the expenditure was proven by relevant documents. We also checked the figures of the general balance of accounts as on December 31, 1958 shown in Table I annexed to this report. The existence on that date of the assets the available and realisable assets in particular was proved.
- "In Table II we give the general account of Ordinary Expenditure and Receipts for 1958 which, after a further allocation of Fr. 15,000 to the provision for special expenditure, shows a deficit of Fr. 239,086.54 written off by withdrawal from the Reserve for General Risks."

The auditors state at the end of their report:

"As a result of our audit, carried out in accordance with the regulations and principles governing the verification of accounts, we are in a position to declare that the annual accounts of the ICRC, as on December 31, 1958, are in accordance with the books submitted for our inspection and that the balance sheet shows the exact financial situation of your institution."

Table III gives the details of the contributions made to the ICRC in 1958 by the Governments and National Red Cross Societies, and the International Committee wishes to express once more its sincere thanks for the generous aid it has thus received in carrying out its work.

Table IV gives a summary of the General Account for Relief Actions in 1958, Table V shows a summary of estimated expenditure and receipts for 1959 and Table VI concerns the accounts for special Funds which the auditors have also verified and found to be correct according to their report of January 31, 1959.
