## III. FINANCIAL POSITION

As in previous years the annual accounts of the ICRC have been audited by the Société fiduciaire romande OFOR S. A. (auditors recognized by the Swiss Federal Council and the Commission fédérale des banques) which certified the financial position of the International Committee for 1963 to be correct, as shown in the annexed Tables I to VI.

The manifold activities undertaken by the ICRC during the course of the past year entailed a certain increase of expenditure in excess of estimates. The events of the Centenary, the Exhibition and the Congress, in particular, overran the item "Allowances, salaries and wages" by an amount of approximately 215,000 Sw.frs. in relation to the budget. Furthermore, extraordinary expenditure, resulting from the ICRC medico-surgical relief mission in the Yemen, by itself reached a total of nearly 614,000 Sw.frs.

The regular financing of the ICRC depends, it should be recalled, on the generosity of the States parties to the Geneva Conventions, as well as of the National Red Cross Societies. For its relief actions, the ICRC is pleased to be able to count on the proceeds of its annual collection in Switzerland and on special payments made to it by governments, National Red Cross Societies and private donors.

The efforts made during the centenary year by all who contributed to the financing of the Committee's activities entitle one to hope for a readjustment of contributions, which the ever-increasing rise in the cost of living and the decrease in purchasing power has rendered indispensable.

The ICRC once more expresses its gratitude to all those who assure its financial support without which it could not continue to carry out its mission.

#### Examination of the financial results :

#### Table I.—ICRC Balance Sheet as on December 31, 1963

As the Balance Sheet shows, on the one hand, the increase of expenditure over ordinary receipts for the year, viz. 704,727.70 Sw.frs., has been placed in the Reserve for General Risks, and, on the other hand, the deficit outstanding at the end of 1963, for the ICRC relief action in Nepal (1,496,738.61 Sw.frs of which 1,300,730.21 was brought forward from 1962) and in the Yemen (613,840.89 Sw.frs.) has been provisionally transferred to assets.

### Table II.—General Account of Ordinary Expenditure and Receipts in 1963

The budget for 1963 estimated a deficit of 580,000 Sw.frs. which the expenses incurred during the period brought to 704,724.70 Sw.frs., in spite of an increase in contributions registered in the Centenary Year.

### Table III.—List of contributions to the ICRC in 1963 from Governments and National Red Cross Societies.

Total receipts, which we would emphasize constitute the very basis of the International Committee's regular financing, only covered approximately half of the institution's ordinary expenditure.

#### Table IV.—Summary of General Account for Relief Actions in 1963

Amongst other items under the heading of receipts is shown the net product of the ICRC's appeal in Switzerland (annual collection) which showed an increase over previous years and amounted to 766,933.20 Sw.frs.

### Table V.—Summary Estimate of Ordinary Expenditure and Receipts of the ICRC for 1964

This estimate has been based on the actual current requirements of the ICRC. In other words, any change in the international situation can oblige the International Committee to face unexpected extensions to its activities and consequently to its financial needs.
