# INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS DIVISION

The International Organizations Division is the section of the Department of Operations that represents the ICRC in its contacts with international organizations, whether governmental or non-governmental, and keeps them informed about the institution's operations and policies. It also follows the work of the international organizations in areas of interest to the ICRC. This helps increase awareness of humanitarian problems in international circles.

At the beginning of the year the ICRC delegation in New York, which represents the ICRC as an observer in the United Nations General Assembly, forwarded to the United Nations Secretariat copies of the agreements reached under ICRC auspices between the parties to the conflict in the former Yugoslavia.

In January the ICRC, together with New York University, organized the tenth seminar on international humanitarian law for diplomats accredited to the United Nations. A similar seminar was held in Geneva, jointly with the Graduate Institute of International Studies, for the first time in April.

A cooperation agreement between the Organization of African Unity (OAU) and the ICRC was signed in May by the OAU Secretary General, Mr. Salim A. Salim, and ICRC President Sommaruga.

In Geneva the International Organizations Division followed the work of the United Nations Commission on Human Rights (in February and March), the World Health Assembly, ECOSOC and the special session on the former Yugoslavia held by the Commission on Human Rights, at which the ICRC made a statement. Members of the Division also attended a coordination meeting on Somalia organized by the United Nations Department of Humanitarian Affairs.

In addition, the Division kept up regular contacts with the Council of Europe and representatives of parliamentary groups within the European Parliament. On 7 October the ICRC President made a declaration to the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, which adopted a resolution in support of the ICRC.

As in previous years, members of the Division attended numerous international meetings, such as the OAU summit in Senegal, the summit of the Non-Aligned Movement in Jakarta and the General Assembly of the Organization of American States (OAS) in the Bahamas. The Division was also represented at several seminars and colloquia on humanitarian law.

In the autumn the International Organizations Division focused on the United Nations General Assembly in New York, where it followed many of the discussions. In connection with the United Nations Decade of International Law, it expressed the ICRC's views on the protection of the environment in situations of armed conflict, the applicability and dissemination of international humanitarian law among peacekeeping forces, ratification of the Protocols additional to the Geneva Conventions and the ICRC's work in relation to conventional weapons

and new weapons technology. Also during the General Assembly the ICRC President took part in a round table on humanitarian issues organized by the Third Committee. He also took the floor in plenary session to discuss the important issue of the coordination of humanitarian assistance, stating in particular: "The increasing politicization of humanitarian work does not favour respect for the law. While it is encouraging to see that humanitarian issues are higher on the agenda of the international community today, the trend towards politicization is worrying and must be checked. This calls for a more precise division of tasks and responsibilities between the

humanitarian organizations that are working to alleviate suffering and the political bodies whose duty it is to tackle the causes of conflict".

Moreover, the International Organizations Division followed the proceedings of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees and the International Organization for Migration. Its representatives, sometimes accompanied by regional delegates, also attended the meeting of the Inter-Parliamentary Union in Stockholm and the seventh summit of Heads of State of the Organization of the Islamic Conference in Dakar and the Conference's extraordinary meetings in Istanbul and Jeddah.
