THE REVIEW “L'ENSEIGNEMENT MATHÉMATIQUE”

At its reunion of 2nd July 1955, held at Geneva, the Executive Committee of the I.C.M.I. decided that the review *L'Enseignement Mathématique* was to be considered the official organ of the Commission.

The first series of *L'Enseignement Mathématique* has just ended with the publication of the volume XL. The new series is expected to appear soon. This second series will be devoted to the reform and development of mathematical instruction; it will publish articles focusing on and explaining modern theories

in a manner comprehensible to non-specialised mathematicians; deal with the arrangement and organisation of teaching; study the psychological formation of mathematical ideas; and publish accounts of the work done and surveys carried out by the I.C.M.I. A bibliographical index will be included in each number.

As the new series of *L'Enseignement Mathématique* only appeared in 1955, the International Mathematical Union at its meeting of 1st September 1954, during which the status of the I.C.M.I. was established, was unable to consider the setting aside of funds or subsidies for the review. However the I.C.M.I. deems it its duty to support this publication by doing its best to increase the number of subscribers. The National Sub-Committees are obviously in a position to take an active part in making this publication known, so the Office of the I.C.M.I. counts on their whole-hearted support for this purpose.

The annual subscription fee is 20 swiss francs (or the equivalent in other currency), for four numbers making up a volume of about three hundred pages.

Perhaps the National Sub-Committees could find out the number of possible subscribers. If these were to number a hundred or more, the Administration of *L'Enseignement Mathématique* would be prepared to make a reduction up to 25% on the subscription fee.

The Secretariat is always ready to print any texts the National Sub-Committees may require and which might help to make this publication better known.
