1. NEW MEMBERS. ICMI is pleased to welcome into membership Cuba, Ghana and the Ivory Coast.

2. ICME 5. The Proceedings of ICME 5 held at Adelaide in 1984 will be published by Birkhäuser before December, 1985. The volume contains the plenary lectures given by D'Ambrosio (Brazil), Kahane (France), Kilpatrick (USA) and Potts (Australia) together with review papers from each of the action, theme and topic groups.

3. ICME 6. The Sixth International Congress will be held in Budapest, Hungary from 27 July to 3 August, 1988. Congress activities will again include lectures, seminars, workshops, films, poster sessions and exhibitions. A detailed second announcement will be available in mid-1987. 4. ICMI STUDIES

a) *The Impact of Computers and Informatics on Mathematics and its Teaching*

A successful meeting was held in Strasbourg in March 1985. The Proceedings will be published by Cambridge University Press on 1 January 1986. A collection of fifty 'Supporting Papers' has been published by the Strasbourg IREM, 10, rue du Général Zimmer, 67084 Strasbourg-Cedex, France (price 100FF including postage). A follow-up meeting will be held in Marseilles in January, 1986 (details from Dr. F. Pluvinaige at the Strasbourg IREM).

b) *School Mathematics in the 1990s*

A discussion document prepared by A. G. Howson, B. Nebres and B. J. Wilson is available from the ICMI Secretariat, Centre for Mathematics Education, The University, Southampton, SO9 5NH, England.

A small international seminar on the theme will be held in Kuwait in February, 1986 under the patronage of the Kuwait Foundation for the Advancement of Science.

A monograph will be published by the Cambridge University Press in late 1986.

c) *Mathematics as a Service Subject*

It is hoped to publish a discussion document on this topic in the first issue of *L'Enseignement Mathématique* in 1986. An international meeting, on the pattern of that held in Strasbourg, is planned for March/April 1987.
