Our best customers. During the month of June last the exports to Germany amounted to 16,1 Million fr. against 14,6 Millions in May. France takes second place 12,5 Millions against 11,3 Millions in May. Great Britain is third with 11,4 Millions (11,6 M.) Then follow the United States of America with 8,7 Millions (8,3 M.-, Italy with 7,9 Millions (8 M.) Schecko-Slovakia with 6,6 Millions (4,5 M.) Imports from Germany rose from 32,7 to 36,2 Millions: from France from 18,7 to 20,6 Millions and from Italy from 9 to 11,6 Millions.

NEWS IN BRIEF.

Last June, Switzerland's Radio licenses numbered 475,486.

During the first six months of 1937, 1,613 persons emigrated overseas from Switzerland, compared with 886 last year.

Shares and securities have changed on the Exchange in Zurich to the extent of 2897 million francs against 1490 Million francs last year.

At the 4th Meeting on the lake of Zurich for the sailing championships of Europe, Switzerland was first with 408 points. Then followed Italy with 369 points, Hungary 365, Austria 327, England 312, Germany 260 and France 211 points.
