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WELLINGTON SWISS EVACUATION SCHEME FOR WOMEN AND CHILDREN, IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY.

Our Swiss fellow countrymen at Wellington have completed arrangements for evacuating Swiss women and children to a cottage about 25 miles out of Wellington, in case a national emergency should arise.
