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various items of much general interest about Switzerland, contributed by the "Auslandschweizersekretariat", accompanied by photographs, and official news from the authorities in Switzerland, and news from the Embassy. These four numbers would be sent to each Swiss family and unmarried Swiss national (living alone) registered with the Embassy. For this special issue, the texts, written in English, and the cliches for the photographs, would be sent from Bern, to the Embassy, who in turn, would transmit them to the Editing Committee, from whom the printers would receive the material.


The "Helvetia" would be sent from the printers to the Embassy, who would distribute it. The total cost of these four issues would be covered by the Swiss Government.
