The "Helvetica" would be sent from the printers to the Embassy, who would distribute it. The total cost of these four issues would be covered by the Swiss Government.


## International Surface Treatment Fair

Since 1966, every three years and with growing success, Basle has housed the International Surface Treatment Fair. The exhibits on display at this Fair feature in particular the preliminary and subsequent treatments of unfinished parts, galvanotechnics, processes for applying varnishes and paints, as well as the technical plant for the detoxication and neutralisation of the air. The exhibits also include plant for the protection of work personnel and the prevention of accidents. The next "Surface" exhibition is to be held from September 30 to October 4, 1975 in the halls of the Swiss Industries Fair in Basle. This professional exhibition will be accompanied by a number of special press days during which the latest technical achievements in the field of surface treatment will be presented.—(SODT).
