HONOURING HANS WALTER SCHNELLER

Recently a concert was held in Zurich in the honour of the late yodelsongs composer Hans Walter Schneller (1893-1982). During the 1940's and 1950's, Hans Walter Schneller composed well over 200 yodelsongs and thus became one of the best and most popular composers in his field.
