


The Cantonal Flag shows a white, double bearded key on a red background, not to be confused with the single bearded, red-and-white key of the other half-Canton with similar name. There are approx 32,000 inhabitants in the "half-Canton" in question. The highest point or elevation is the 'Rotstöckli' with 2901 meters. The lowest point is to be found near the lake of Lucerne (Vierwaldstättersee) with 434 meters.
