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


Do you know the name of this Swiss tourist destination ?

To reach this destination at an altitude of 5900 feet, for a holiday below the highest peaks in Canton Valais, you would leave the 'Rhône-valley' at Visp continue on to Stalden and travel either by car or Postal-coach to the end of the valley (with the same name) and **to the left** of the well-known 'Mattertal'. This town has been kept car-free and all cars must be left at the car park just outside the village. Since 1951, the time the road was completed, this resort has experienced a tremendous boom, offering winter and summer skiing. The Metro-Alpine funicular, the highest underground railway in the world, whisks skiers up to the 11,483-foot Mittelallalin-mountain. The top-station restaurant offers a dreamlike view. There are 56 hotels offering 2500 beds and a further 4700 beds in chalets and apartments.
