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

The world famous Hotel Victoria-Jungfrau built in 1860 is situated here. Another landmark is the Kursaal with its splendid garden and the famous floral clock. Last year, unfortunately, the name of the resort in question was part of news headlines in connection with a tragic canyoning disaster.
